- 1. Minutes from the previous meeting on 14th October approved.
- 2. HH advised that BDC use PLACE to look at heritage as regards planning. HH confirming whether PLACE had done any work in the parish. DW advised that we also need to consider significant buildings, i.e. those thought to be important to parishioners but that remain unlisted. The NPSC needs to generate an initial list and then present these to the public for feedback and possible expansion of the list. AR has the beginning of the list and will pass on to HH. HH to continue investigating PLACE.

3. There followed a discussion regarding opening up NPSC meetings to the public using a format similar to that used by the Parish Council namely with a public participation session before and after the usual agenda items. It was decided to publicise an online public meeting held using Zoom. The nature of the meeting would be publicised on social media, websites and in the PC magazine with the public asked to register an interest in advance either by email or telephone. This would allow the NPSC to determine whether one or more sessions would be required to accommodate all interested parties. DW to contact Mr Dunn as regards his building plans to ensure that no other buildings would be built. DW also to draft a response to the landowners that had submitted the sites so far.
